ALTERNATE ROUTE PROGRAM

PROGRAM DEFINITION:

The Alternate Route Program allows a person who does not hold a probationary or temporary appointment as a police officer, but who is seeking such an appointment, to enroll in the Basic Training Course for Police Officers. Upon successful completion of the program, graduates will have received training from a certified police academy and be able to pursue employment as a police officer.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

An Alternate Route Program applicant must meet the following standards:

- The applicant must be a citizen of the United States;
- The applicant must be in good health;
- The applicant must be able to read, write, and speak the English language fluently;
- The applicant must be of good moral character, and shall not have been convicted of any criminal offense involving moral turpitude;
- The applicant must be between the ages of 18 to 34;
- The applicant must have a valid driver's license.

An Alternate Route Program applicant must meet an education standard requiring a minimum of 60 academic credits earned from a regionally accredited or Middle States accredited college or university, or meet a military service standard requiring military service with either an Honorable Discharge or a General Discharge under Honorable Conditions, in order to be considered for admission to the Alternate Route Program.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The Monmouth County Police Academy (MCPA) shall utilize the most recent list of the **MONMOUTH COUNTY POLICE CHIEF'S ENTRY LEVEL EXAMINATION FOR NON-CIVIL SERVICE MUNICIPALITIES** in the selection of Alternate Route candidates. The MCPA shall accept applications for the exam from all qualified individuals, and does not limit the application process and/or admission to the program to a specific geographic location.

The MCPA invites candidates to apply for the Alternate Route Program based on the test scores recorded after the most recent Monmouth County Police Chief's Exam for Non-Civil Service Municipalities. Highest scoring exam takers who have also passed the physical component of the Chief's Exam, and meet the education requirement, will be invited to apply for the Alternate Route Program.

Applicants must also successfully complete the following elements:

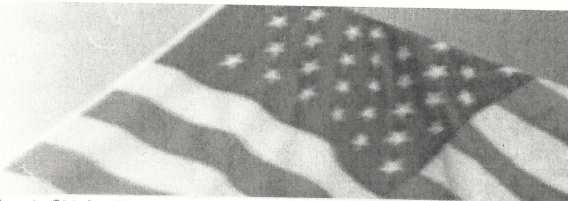
- **Structured Oral Interview** conducted by an Interview Panel,
- **Psychological Examination** to determine suitability for employment in law enforcement,
- **Medical Examination** to determine suitability for employment in law enforcement, as well as the ability to participate in physical activities required during the Basic Course for Police Officers,
- **Drug Testing** as set forth in the *Attorney General's Law Enforcement Drug Testing Policy*,
- **Background Investigation** to determine the suitability of each applicant for a position of trust and responsibility as a police officer.

FEES:

Alternate Route applicants are responsible for the cost of registration for The Monmouth Police Chief's Entry Level Examination for Non-Civil Service Municipalities(\$60), as well as the cost for tuition, educational supplies, uniforms, ammunition, and other items which are normally provided to regular police trainees by government employers. (Fees are estimated to total approximately \$3,000). A limited number of scholarships are available to graduates who possess economic need.

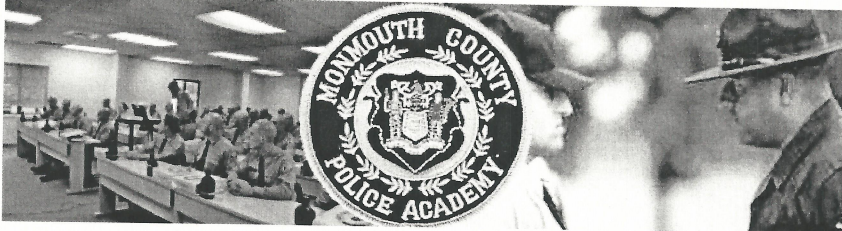

A Police Officer's Entry Level Examination for all non-civil service municipalities located within Monmouth County will be conducted at the Monmouth County Police Academy, 2000 Kozloski Road, Freehold, NJ.

Alternate Route candidates will be selected from this Non-Civil Service Eligibility List

To Be Eligible, candidates must meet these guidelines:

- Must be between the ages of 18 to 34
- Must have a valid driver's license
- Must be a high school graduate
- Must be a U. S. citizen
- Out of County residence eligible

Examination will be administered on the following dates: JUNE 3, 4, and 5, 2013

You will be informed of your testing date at registration
